


U3A3 – Applying International Curricula


Performance Outcome

Candidates recommend an appropriate global educational system for an international school or school system




Scope

- Select an international school in one of the regions or countries you have investigated. The school can be real or fictional, but at present it is following its own curriculum; it has not implemented either the IB or CIE. The school can be primary, secondary, or K-12.
- The school now wants to implement an international curriculum, and they have asked you do research, report on, and recommend the most suitable one



Scope 2

- Write a report to present to the Board of Directors and parents with your recommendation. As you prepare the report, you should:
 - Summarize the needs of the school, students, and other stakeholders. Include school demographics
 - Summarize the pros and cons of both the IB and CIE in general and with reference to your school
 - Make a preliminary recommendation for one of the systems and support your recommendation with logic and examples, or,
 - If you need more information in order to make a recommendation, state what information you need, how your committee should get that information, and the logic for needing this additional information



Deliverables

- A formal report with references
- Use charts and other graphics for illustration as needed
- Include title and headings
