Performance Outcome

- Candidates understand the importance of collaborating with their mentor as they plan for student learning
- Candidates demonstrate their understanding of lesson planning; differentiation; and classroom expectations and routines as they plan their first days of clinical practice with their mentor teacher



Scope

- Record a meeting with your mentor
- **With your mentor, discuss:**
 - lessons that you will teach during your first week
 - classroom expectations and routines
 - learning standards, units, and objectives that will be covered while you are working in the classroom
 - the TEACH-NOW rubric
- Edit video down to 5-10 minutes
- Upload video to Google Docs (or other) and submit link



Deliverables

- Video recording of your meeting with your mentor
- A written summary of the classroom expectations and routines and the learning standards as well as the units and objectives that will be covered while you are working in the classroom



Notes

This activity is largely about making sure you have worked out all the technical aspects of recording, editing and uploading.

But it's also, obviously, about making sure you and your mentor are on the same page. Be sure to review the rubric and discuss questions identified on activity page.
